Contested Cultural Heritage - Religion, Nationalism ...

Although "contested cultural heritage" has not always been specified in these words, the concept has been cogently present for at least 25 years in anthropology, archaeology, history, geography, architecture, urbanism, and tourism (to name the most obvious disciplines) and is now a framework driving much applied research in these fields internationally.

Contested Cultural Heritage: A Selective Historiography ...

Jasper Chalcraft, from the University of Sussex, explains why cultural heritage can be contested: When different views of heritage are opposed and conflictual. When the very notion of cultural heritage is contested. He emphasizes the contrast between two approaches to cultural heritage: 'guardianship', defended by the Maori people in New Zealand, as opposed to 'ownership', which is dominant in Europe.
